Studies Reveal COVID-19 Vaccine Risks

Concentrations in Ovaries, Bone Marrow & Lymph Nodes Dangers for Men, Women, Teens & Preborn

Experimental COVID-19 vaccines – all of which either use, or were at one point tested on, aborted fetal cells - are now being injected throughout the U.S. under “Emergency Use Authorization,” and, although not widely reported in the mainstream media, doctors, scientists and the CDC are reporting serious vaccine-related side effects and even deaths of men, women, teens, and preborn children.

Megan Redshaw of *Children’s Health Defense*, a non-profit established to “end childhood health epidemics”, is doing excellent reporting on problems with the vaccines:

“COVID vaccine researchers had previously assumed mRNA COVID vaccines would behave like traditional vaccines. The vaccine’s spike protein — responsible for infection and its most severe symptoms — would remain mostly in the injection site at the shoulder muscle or local lymph nodes”

But the spike protein is traveling... in a deadly way.

“We made a big mistake. We didn’t realize it until now,” said Byram Bridle, a viral immunologist and associate professor at University of Guelph, Ontario. “We thought the spike protein was a great target antigen, we never knew the spike protein itself was a toxin and was a pathogenic protein. So by vaccinating people we are inadvertently inoculating them with a toxin.”

Bridle goes on to explain that when the purified spike protein is injected into the blood of research animals, they experienced damage to the cardiovascular system and it crosses the blood-brain barrier. The biodistribution study:

“shows the COVID spike protein gets into the blood where it circulates for several days post-vaccination and then accumulates in organs and tissues including the spleen, bone marrow, the liver, adrenal glands and in ‘quite high concentrations’ in the ovaries.”

“Stephanie Seneff, senior research scientists at Massachusetts Institute of Technology, said it is now clear vaccine content is being delivered to the spleen and the glands, including the ovaries and the adrenal glands, and is being shed into the medium and then eventually reaches the bloodstream causing systemic damage.”

“Dr. J. Patrick Whelan, a pediatric rheumatologist, warned the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) in December mRNA vaccines could cause microvascular injury to the brain, heart, liver and kidneys in ways not assessed in safety trials.”

Last month, the [FDA/CDC](#) Vaccine Safety Team released shocking results of teen males having up to 40 times higher than expected incidents of myocarditis & pericarditis heart damage following the 2nd dose of Pfizer or Moderna mRNA vaccines. The CDC has investigated just 285 of the 475 cases reported and discovered 15 teens are still hospitalized (3 in intensive care units).

As I noted in [last month's newsletter](#), we at Pikes Peak Citizens for Life were happy to learn that our latest advertisement placed in the *Colorado Springs Independent* (also known as the *Indy*) was catalyzing a conversation about abortion and its effects on our community.

Or at least that is the conclusion we drew when [Amy Gillentine, the Indy's publisher, offered](#) "starting a conversation with those we disagree with - in order to learn about each other and find common ground."
